3. RACE CLASS

The race is among the events organized by PZKol (Polish Cycling Association) and its results are counted to Challenge.

Race class: 2.1

4. PARTICIPATION

All race participants, in view of the current situation resulting from epidemic in Poland, are REQUIRED to keep safety rules, orders and prohibitions. It is recommended for coaches and team managers to measure the temperature of participants. In case of temperature above 37°C, the contestant CANNOT take part in the competition.

The race will take place between 13 and 15/08/2020 within the area of Dzierżoniów Municipality and the final in Bagno (Oborniki Śląskie), according to the rules of UCI and PZKol.

The race will consist of three stages:

Stage 1 Roztocznik	RR 13/08/2020	10 and 15 rounds x $6.7 \text{ km} = 67,0 \text{ km}$ and 100.5 km
Stage 2 Ostroszowice	RR 14/08/2020	9 and 12 rounds x 8.7 km = 78,3 km and 104.4 km
Stage 3 Bagno	ITT 15/08/2020	16 km

Only contestants who hold a sports license, current medical tests, OC and AD&D insurance can participate in the race.

1. START FEE

Contestants who applied by 6/08/2020 through the application form pay the fee according to the rules of Polish Cycling Association.

2. RACE OFFICE

The Race Office will be open on the day of the competition, i.e. 13/08/2020 from 9.00 to 11.00 in Hotel Niemcza Spa, ul. Strzelińska 8, 58-230 Niemcza.

Representatives of teams and contestants must confirm their participation in "Owl Mountains Tour" by presenting a license in the Race Office and start fee payment confirmation.

Technical briefing will take place in the Race Office in Hotel Niemcza Spa, ul. Strzelińska 8, 58-230 Niemcza in the presence of the Main Referee, Race manager and Security manager representing the Police on 13/08/2020 at 11.30.

3. TECHNICAL HELP

The organizer does not provide a neutral vehicle.

4. RULES FOR THE LAST 3 KILOMETERS

If there is a failure or a fall at the last 3 kilometers, a contestant will be classified with the time of contestants who that contestant was riding with at the time of the event, and will be classified at a position that he/she was having when crossing the finish line. If he/she cannot cross the finish line because of the accident, they will be classified at the last position of that stage.

5. TIME LIMIT

Stage I and II competitors will be removed from the route when the start to the leading group is 10 minutes.

6. CLASSIFICATION AND BONUSES

General classification – white/red T-shirt – Ministry of Sports

The race will be held in terms of individual classification. The individual classification is held according to the rules of Polish Cycling Association Sports Rules and UCI and according to regulations herein.



The individual winner is the contestant who has the lowest number when stage times, bonuses and time penalties are added together.

Contestants who will rank the first three at the finish line of stage 1 and 2 will receive respectively 10, 6, 4 seconds of bonus given after a given stage.

Sprint classification – a blue T-shirt – sponsor AKLIMASERWS company

During stage 1 and 2 there will be awarded an intermediate bonus between the START/FINISH line – lap 3, 6 and 9. Contestants receive points in the sprint classification as follows: 1^{st} place - 5 points, 2^{nd} place - 3 points, 3^{rd} place - 1 point.

Mountain classification – a green T-shirt - sponsor BOXMET Sp. z o.o. company and DEDAL sp. z o.o. sp. k. Transport Company.

During stage 1 and 2 a mountain bonus will be awarded. Contestants receive points in the mountain classification as follows: Stage 1 – lap 4 (22 km), 8 (48.8km), 10 (62.2km) 1^{st} place - 5 points, 2^{nd} place - 3 points, 3^{rd} place - 1 point.

Stage 2 – lap 4 (27.2km), 8 (62km), 10 (79.4km): <u>1st place</u> - 7 point, <u>2nd place</u> - 5 points, <u>3rd place</u> - 3 points.

Team classification - ATOM DWELOPER Sp. z o.o. Wrocław Cup

According to item 2.6.016 of UCI rules team classification will be held after each stage based on three best times of participants from a given team (elite, U23+junior women). Teams that do not have 3 participants will not be counted in the team classification.

8. DECORATION CEREMONY

The decoration in given categories will take place about 15 minutes after their end.

9. SAFETY RULES

During the race the roads where the route goes will be closed for public traffic. The traffic will be allowed only at suitable times (such as breaks between groups or categories) in the same direction as the cyclists go.

In front of the race leader there will be a pilot police car or motor bike. Contestants do not follow the road signs and groups that are not preceded by a race pilot should ride along the ride side of the road.

17. FINAL PROVISIONS

In all matters not included in the regulations, decides the Main Referee in agreement with Race Manager.

All additional information/announcements will be given during the technical briefing.

Every participant takes part in the race on their own responsibility. Contestants below 18 – on the responsibility of their caretaker who signed an agreement and cannot make any claims in this respect towards the organizer, Polish Cycling Association or UCI.

Every contestant is obliged to observe the orders of the referees and organizers as well as to observe regulations herein.

All contestants are obliged to ride in protective helmets that are in accordance with the current safety standards.

The organizer is not materially responsible for sports equipment or personal belongings lost during the race.

The organizer cannot be blamed for accidents caused by race participants or random accidents that happen while arriving to or leaving the spot of the race.

Protests can be reported according to the rules of Polish Cycling Association and UCI.

18. GREEN ZONE

During stage 1 of the race the GREEN ZONE is located at 400 meters behind the START/FINISH line, on the right-hand side.

During stage 2 of the race the GREEN ZONE is located at 200 meters behind the START/FINISH line, on the right-hand side.

Contestants can trash their water bottles and rubbish. The GREEN ZONE will be cleaned by Organizing Staff as soon as the End of Race Car arrives.
